COVID SAFTEY PROTOCOL UPDATE FROM THE DIOCESE OF NJ

<u>For the fully Vaccinated</u> – Masks do not need to be worn inside or outside, social distancing is not necessary. The lectern side of the Church is open seating. Sit where you like and with whom you like. It is OK to sing and to use the Prayer Books, Hymnals in the pew racks.

<u>For Children, Youths and the Unvaccinated</u> – Masks need to be worn inside and social distancing observed. The pulpit side of the Church is for restricted seating for family units and others who observe social distancing. It is OK to sing and use the books in the pew racks.

<u>For All</u> – Its always OK to wear a mask anywhere and stay distanced as you are comfortable. If you don't feel well, stay home and watch the service on-line. As of yet there is no change on how we receive communion or the distanced exchange of the Peace.
