The Virtual Art Show and announcement of contest winners is scheduled to be up on our web site and social media on or about February 22nd.



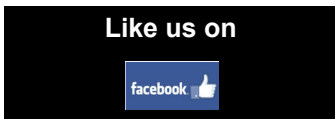

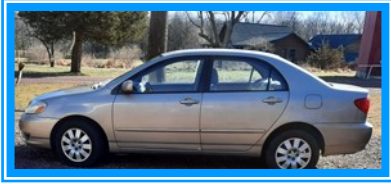

These are some of the changes for this year:

BASIC INFORMATION

YOU can walk in-person at the Voorhees Town Center or virtually at a location of your choice. All Walkers **MUST** register online at www.ihocsj.org. There is a tab for Mall Walk 2021 and a drop down menu. Click to register on line.

The Registration fee is \$25 which includes this year’s brand new T-shirt.

The in person Walk will be a socially distant one with everyone required to wear a MASK. TEAMS will be walking between 12:00 Noon and 3:00 PM, with their time assigned in advance. Individual Walkers will be walking between 3:00 PM and 5:00 PM.

When you walk the Route, you will see stations located about every 50 to 100 feet with socially distant tables for fun activities, entertainment, or information about local businesses or non-profits.

You will walk the Route only once, and Goodie Bags will be given out at the end of the Walk

Virtual Walkers will pick the location for their walk and will walk for as long as they like. Virtual Walkers may send a short video of the walk to IHOC’s Facebook Group, which can also be accessed at our website through the Mall Walk 2021
