In my last month's message I optimistically announced that IHOC was going to be able to have a Hospitality Network from February to May 2022. However, after our December newsletter "went to press" Sonya received new information which made it clear that we would need to be prepared to quarantine our participants if one or more of them tested positive for Covid or were exposed to someone who had. We also realized that we would need to be able to care for cli-

ents who became sick. In light of these facts and news of a new, faster spreading Covid variant, we convened a Network Committee meeting to reconsider our plans for the Network. At that meeting we all agreed that having the Network no longer made sense because we did not have the ability to safeguard our clients and volunteers if someone in the program tested positive for or became sick from Covid. This decision was approved by the IHOC Board of Directors at its December 14th meeting.

Although we will not be able to have a Network beginning in February, IHOC is committed to spending 2022 finding ways to expand our mentoring program and to improve our Hospitality Network. We are also committed to finding a property that we can turn into a new transitional house.

Thank you for understanding. Please keep us in your prayers


