Sonya Jacobs, our case manager, will be our liaison with a local real estate agent and will be coordinating viewings of available properties and committee meetings.

IHOC is looking for a house that is located within walking distance of a reliable bus route and shopping. We would like a house with a minimum of three bedrooms and two bathrooms which also includes a finished basement or separate family room that can be used for meetings and classes. Room for outside activities and a possible addition is also part of our wish list.

This is a tall order! However, IHOC has already raised over \$60,000 in our capital campaign and a generous friend of IHOC is willing to give us a \$200,000 mortgage at 2% interest. So, we are on our way and I firmly believe that if transitional housing is part of God's plan for IHOC we will have good news to share with you soon.

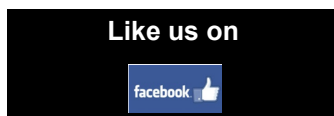


MENTORS WANTED

MALL WALK 2021

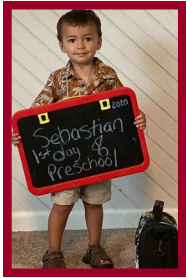
